

The deadline for submission of full papers to the Fifth Australian Conference on Laser Diagnostics in Fluid Mechanics and Combustion to be held at UWA has now passed, but there is room in the program for more papers.

There are still opportunities to submit papers to this conference.

If you submit a full paper by September 19th, that paper will go through the review process and you will be notified of the outcome by October 3rd. The deadline for submission of the final paper is October 27th, as it is for all the papers submitted.

If you cannot submit a full paper by September 19th, please submit an abstract (one page or less) by that date. If the full paper is received by October 6th, we can guarantee that the paper will be reviewed. The deadline for submission of the final paper is October 27th.

If an abstract has been submitted but the full paper is not received by October 6th, then the paper may be reviewed by the abstract and you will be notified of the outcome. The deadline for submission of the final paper is still October 27th.

If a final paper is not received by October 27th, we cannot guarantee that the paper will be included on the CD of proceedings for the conference. The abstract may be included on the CD instead.

There are generous grants available for students whose work is relevant to the oil and gas (energy) industries (see www.mech.uwa.edu.au/~poneill/5ACLDFMC/students.html). These grants are currently undersubscribed, but applications can still be submitted if accompanied by a full paper or abstract.

Keynote speakers for the conference are Dr Chris Willert from DLR (German Aerospace Center), Prof Min Gu from Swinburne University and Dr Harald Kleine from ADFA@UNSW.
